Use of Manitoba Trade Definitions

The Manitoba Trade Definitions were created by Manitoba construction trade associations for the purpose of ensuring clarity during the bid submission process. The Trade Definitions attempt to identify all of the specified project tasks and to categorize, by trade, the tasks (scopes) which each type of specialized contractor is best suited to perform on the construction site.

The Winnipeg Construction Association Standard Practice Committee recommends the use of Manitoba Trade Definitions in preparing and submitting bids. Users will find the Trade Definitions helpful in predicting respective responsibilities by trade and in organizing trade pricing for tendered and other projects through the use of uniform definitions of trade tasks.
