Subject: Standard Contract Forms

Members of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada and the Canadian Construction Association, among others, have spent a great deal of time and effort over a period of years in developing mutually acceptable standard contract forms for use in the construction industry right across Canada. These forms present standards that are known and readily understood by the profession and the people in the industry.

The joint MAA/WCA Committee has had their recommendations approved by the Council of the MAA and the Executive of the Winnipeg Construction Association that only current issues of original version format or sealed electronic versions of Canadian Construction Documents Committee and Canadian Construction Association Standard Contract forms should be used in Manitoba and general contractors should expect to sign only Standard Forms. The Copyright Seal which has been affixed to standard documents affirms that the document has not been changed from its original form, with the exception only of additions or modifications as may be set forth in supplementary conditions. Contractors in Manitoba are strongly encouraged to use standard, sealed, construction documents.
